Baby dreams: a non-symbolic sign production

Babies have been known to dream. But since they can only differentiate animated and unanimated beings after six weeks, they cannot use logical icons such as « animated being » or « unanimated being » before that date. They see non-symbolic forms and colours memorized from their experience of darkness, from before they were born, and actual experiences of light and darkness in their first weeks of life.
